The City of Edgerton's first Capital Improvement Plan (CIP) Project Manager will have an opportunity to facilitate projects for new and existing city infrastructure while at the same time ensuring infrastructure is in place to support Logistics Park Kansas City (LPKC), a 1,500-acre inland port capable of handling 17 million square feet of buildings. The CIP Project Manager will develop Edgerton's five-year CIP and will manage projects from concept through design, construction, and close out. The City's newly adopted CIP includes a \$4.1 million community center, a \$15 million grade separation project, local street improvements, and water line replacements. The CIP Project Manager will also represent the city at various local, regional, and state organizations. The CIP Project Manager will report directly to the city administrator and will work closely with the city's community development director, public works and parks staff, and contract city engineer.

Requirements for this position are a bachelor's degree in business, engineering, city or urban planning, public administration or related field and four to six years of progressively responsible related experience. A master's degree in urban planning, public administration or engineering is preferred. Also preferred is experience in budget development, project management, and grant writing.

The hiring salary range is \$56,377 to \$65,698, depending on qualifications, with an excellent benefits package.
